A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Church Family,

As I reflect on this past year at Gospelife, one word comes to mind: Faithful. God has shown himself ever faithful in seasons of growth and celebration, in moments of challenge and hardship, in ways we had hoped, and ways we never anticipated.

2025 ended a three-year spiritual growth journey we called Meant for More. During those three years, God clarified our mission, stretched our faith, and deepened our dependence on Him. Your generosity during M4M fueled more than \$3,000,000 of income beyond our budget, enabling us to add gathering space at Carol Stream, plant Gospelife Washington, and begin construction of dedicated worship space at North Wheaton. During Meant for More, we spent \$912,000 on missions, sent 300 of you on short-term mission trips, and baptized 152 believers – God is faithful!

Last fall brought a challenging season that caused us to wrestle with hurt and disappointment. But amid that hardship, I witnessed our church family band together in love and model gracious maturity. And I am grateful for the patience, prudence, and unity our elders displayed all year. Through it all, God proved himself faithful once again.

So, we look ahead with expectancy and trust. We expect the Lord to bless Gospelife as he has for 25 years. And we trust him to guide our steps into a new season of growth. This February, we will have the honor of sending Tey Mitchell into a lead pastor role – the seventh pastor we have raised up and sent out. Goodbye is never easy for those we love and for whom we have cared, but sending ministry leaders out to expand Kingdom work is at the heart of who we are as a church.

Gospelife is healthiest when we are willing to send our best and trust God to bless what comes next. We have experienced those blessings for decades – we will experience them again. So, I rest in God's promise that he *is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us* (Ephesians 3:20). I am confident that God will bless our church—far more abundantly than we could imagine.
